**Technical Changes from the 2013 Ed. to the 2016 Ed. of NFPA 13 – 4 hours**

The 2016 editions of NFPA's fire sprinkler standards are now available and new rules are being applied to system design and installation practices. New and revised terms, requirements, and applications may impact your strategies relating to project estimating, purchasing, plan review, installation and testing practices. Having the latest and greatest knowledge provides a real advantage over those who are not applying these changes. Upon completion of this seminar, attendees should be able to identify new and revised requirements for fire sprinkler system design, installation and testing; demonstrate an ability to navigate the standard utilizing the table of contents and indexes within; describe the navigational markings used by NFPA standards to identify changes between editions; apply the latest requirements of this new edition to specific designs and installations. The 2016 Edition is currently the referenced standard utilized for the Virginia Construction Code. This will be an information packed class for anyone involved in fire protection design, installation, testing and code enforcement.
